

Policy for Use of IGRINS Sample Data from the May and July 2014 Runs

No sample data have been validated by the team for scientific quality, so proceed with caution when using them for any purpose other than feasibility tests. They remain under control of the IGRINS team with the following exceptions:

- 1. Study:** Any member of the IGRINS user community may examine any of the sample data for the purposes of proposal preparation and feasibility studies.
- 2. Talks:** Any member of the community who requested sample data may show *any* of the sample data (not just their own) in a talk slide. They should notify the PI of the date and venue of the talk for inclusion in our records. Slides with IGRINS data should display the words IGRINS, KASI, and UTexas in the second largest font used and no smaller than 16 pt. Anyone who did not request sample data should ask the IGRINS PI for permission (with a cc. to the KASI IGRINS PI) to show data.
- 3. Posters:** Any member of the community who requested sample data may show *their own* sample data in a conference poster. They should notify the PI (dtj@astro.as.utexas.edu with a cc. to the KASI IGRINS PI chanpark@kasi.re.kr) of the date and venue of the poster session for inclusion in our records. Posters with IGRINS data should display the words IGRINS, KASI, and UTexas prominently.
- 4. Publication in Conference Proceedings or Refereed Journals:** You may not publish sample data in a conference proceeding or journal on its own. Any member of the community who requested sample data may later add those data to a paper containing data from open time, guaranteed time, or legacy proposals by their team. If you requested sample data and wish to also include data you did not yourself request as part of a larger IGRINS sample, please check with the team first via dtj@astro.as.utexas.edu.
- 5. Team publications:** The IGRINS team may publish sample data in the form of team publications. This can be done in consultation with the team leaders at KASI and UT for data taken in the name of a team member and with these leaders and the proposer of the sample data for data taken in someone else's name.
