

How to Join (for Korean)

- For McDonald or DCT
 - Watch out for CfP for IGRINS (~3 times per year)
 - Submit proposals or request forms (for mini-queue)
 - Go to kgmt.kasi.re.kr/kgmtscience and select 'IGRINS' from the menu
- For Gemini
 - Thru K-GMT Science Program w/ Gemini
 - About 10 nights in 2018A

 - Thru US Time (NOAO): Open Sky Policy
 - You may need US collaborators
 - Be a part of IGRINS LLP team – Talk to Greg

Step 1:

- Do you have US collaborators?
- If Yes, then you may try US TAC with your US collaborator as PI.
- In principle, you (Korean researcher) can be a PI on proposals to US TAC ("Open Sky Policy"), but you would need to persuade US TAC why you need US time
- If No, go to Step 2.

Step 2:

- Do you want to find US collaborators for your project?
- If Yes, then please discuss with us, especially Dr. Greg Mace and Dr. Kimberly Sokal, about your project. We will be happy to assist you by finding any prospect collaborators in UT Austin, for example.
- We (IGRINS Team) want to promote as many IGRINS projects as possible in addition to the existing LLP program to expand IGRINS users community base
- If No, go to Step 3.

Step 3:

- KASI manages K-GMT Science Program that gives you access to Gemini about 10 nights per semester
- If you are affiliated with Korean institutes, you can submit proposals to K-GMT Science Program as PI's or Co-I's.
- CfP for 2018A will be released around the end of Aug 2017.
